More and more people will live longer and, in order to preserve their functional capacity and enjoy an independent active life, seniors need specialized and integrated health care.

The COST Action PROmoting GeRiAtric Medicine in countries where it is still eMergING (PROGRAMMING CA 21122) is a consortium project that aims to promote and improve geriatric medicine education among health care professionals especially in countries where geriatrics is still developing.

Romania has an important history and heritage in Geriatric Medicine and although Geriatrics and Gerontology is a recognized, distinct medical specialty, the network of trained health professionals is not well established. Following a similar event of the PROGRAMMING COST Action proceeding in Greece, the Romanian National Society of Geriatrics and Gerontology in collaboration with the European Geriatric Medicine Society (EuGMS) would like to invite you to the Bucharest event entitled "Multidimensional strategies for the preservation of optimal functional capacity for a better ageing".

The event will be a co-organisation with the SPRIN-G, Spring of Geriatrics of the EuGMS and will host a series of lectures and discussions that will highlight the complexity of health and social care for older people, the need for developing a structured network of specialists in geriatric care, national strategies and protocols aligned with the recommendations of recognized experts and professional organisations. Our goal is to involve policy makers, stakeholders, colleagues from different health care settings and specialties in our effort to raise awareness and improve the quality of care for older people.

After a very successful first SPRIN-G last year in Rome on the "Impact of Nutrition on the trajectories of neuro-cognitive aging", we are focusing this year "Multidimensional Strategies for the preservation of optimal functional capacity for a better aging".

SPRIN-G is part of EuGMS' Global Europe Initiative (GEI) efforts to create a new concept of events on major questions related to aging bringing together local and trajectories, international biomedical experts with public health policy makers and social actors, cultural and economic partners. As we did last year in Rome, during the Bucharest event, we will try to make an estimation of the needs in Romania concerning health policies and the training of health professionals on the subject that we develop during this meeting. This year, we have decided to organize the meeting jointly with the PROGRAMMING COST Action 21122, a European project created at the initiative of EuGMS, and which includes partners from 39 countries from all over Europe. This Action is very complementary to the objectives of the GEI since it aims to develop education and training in geriatrics for all health professionals, particularly in countries where geriatric medicine is less developed.

We hope you all enjoy this very exciting meeting.
